Letter of Requirement

The Muskogee County Farm Bureau respectfully submits to your students the opportunity to apply for the Muskogee County Farm Bureau Scholarship.

The Scholarship will be selected, and the recipients will be notified by letter.

The total amount of the scholarship will be \$1,000 to be applied as follows:
\$500 for the Fall semester and \$500 for the Spring semester.

If one of your students receive this scholarship and chooses not to return for the second semester or does not average a 2.5 GPA, he/she will not receive the second half of the scholarship.

Completed applications need to be returned to the Muskogee County Farm Bureau office, located at 28 E Shawnee in Muskogee (Orscheln's parking lot), no later than April 2, 2021.

Requirements:

- 1. Parents/ Legal Guardian must be a member (and current on dues) of Muskogee County Farm Bureau for at least 1 year and must remain a member during the duration of the scholarship.**
- 2. Graduate in 2021. Must be High School senior or presently enrolled in College, Vo-Tech or Trade School. Post Graduate studies excluded.**
- 3. Scholarship can only be awarded one time.**
- 4. Be required to carry a minimum of 12 hours, per semester or equivalent in Technical or Trade School.**
- 5. GPA requirement for High School and College work is 2.5.**
- 6. Application must be filled out COMPLETELY**
- 7. Must have ACT score enclosed with application.**
- 8. Certified copy of your transcript from High School or College covering last semesters work, must be submitted.**
- 9. Must show financial need for scholarship.**
- 10. Each applicant must submit a DOUBLE-SPACED TYPED AUTOBIOGRAPHY stating objective of study; also, may include any additional information which would be of interest to the scholarship selection committee.**
