## **Critical Thinking**

Critical thinking – the ability to go beyond basic knowledge and consider "the bigger picture" – is a crucial skill for school success. The better students are able to think critically, the more deeply they will grasp new concepts and ideas. To promote these skills:

- Let your child figure things out. Resist the urge to solve every problem. Instead, give them time to work through problems themselves. Give them space to come up with a plan.
- **Discuss current events.** Is there a news story that might interest them? Print out an article and chat about it over dinner.
- Encourage reflection. Once your child completes a big project for school, talk about it. Regardless of how the project went, reflecting on the process will help them hone their critical thinking skills.
