

CAFETERIA ITEMS

Students in PK – 5th grades will use their picture ID cards for lunch. The classroom teachers will keep the cards and give them to the children when it is time to go to lunch. You are **strongly** urged to pay for your child's breakfast and lunch in advance. Lunch is \$2.75 a day, \$27.50 will pay for two weeks or 10 lunches. Breakfast is \$1.75 a day or \$17.50 for two weeks. Your child will not be able to charge more than \$20.00 for either breakfast or lunch. It will be very important to remember to pay for lunches and/or breakfast in advance if possible.
