

Parrett - Light - Cook Memorial Scholarship Award Criteria

The Parrett-Light-Cook Memorial Scholarship is established in memory of Chad Alan Parrett, Jamie Don Light, and Wesley Scott Cook who died in an auto accident on November 24, 1990. They were 1990 graduates of Hilldale High School.

Kathy Westhoff founded the scholarship. It is meant to be a living tribute to the memory of three young men who were just beginning their college life with great anticipation.

The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the amount of interest earned on the principle invested in the Scholarship. The annual interest earned and rounded DOWN to the nearest \$500 multiple will determine the amount of the annual scholarship awarded.

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES: DUE MAY 5th

1. Must be a graduating member of the senior class of Hilldale High School.
2. Must have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 through 3.5.
3. Must have an ACT composite score of 19 and all sub-scores of at least 19.
4. Must provide a 500 to 1000 word written essay on the topic of "How continuing education will affect my future".
5. Must have 2 teachers (one must be the Senior English teacher) submit recommendations to the school counselor (forms provided).

JUDGING:

1. The judges will be:
 - Senior Class sponsor
 - School counselor
 - School Principal
2. Judging will be based on the essay & teacher recommendations.
3. The scholarship will be awarded at the senior assembly and will be presented by one of the family members, if available.
